Exit Interview Questions

Opening Introduction (2 minutes)

The interview will begin with the student using his/her portfolio and experience in the career certification program to introduce him/herself focused on sharing his/her accomplishments, traits, and skills.

Questions to Ask Students (8 minutes)

Each judge will select 2-3 questions to ask students from the list below. Those same questions should be asked of all the students interviewed by your panel.

- What is your career interest and why do you want to work in that field?
- What motivates you? What do you have a passion for?
- What are your greatest strengths? Your weaknesses?
- Why should an employer hire you? What sets you apart from others?
- What is your biggest achievement? Your biggest failure?
- What are your goals after graduation? After five years? After 10 years? Why have you chosen those goals?
- What motivated you to get involved in the Certificate Program?
- How has your involvement in the program prepared you for your future?
- Tell us about your internship experience: Where was it and what did you learn?
- What part(s) of your portfolio are you most proud of and why?

If time remains, you may ask additional questions.

Closing Question and Final Comments

At the end of the interview, ask the final question shown below followed by any comments you would like to share.

- Is there anything else you would like to share with the panel that you want us to know?
